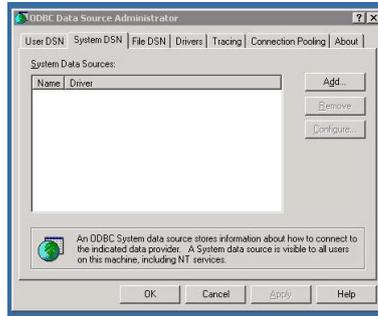


Setting up Navision 2.60, 3.60, 3.70 and 4.0 for use in timeXtender:

Go to Control Panel -> Administrative Tools -> Data Sources (ODBC) and click the System DSN tab

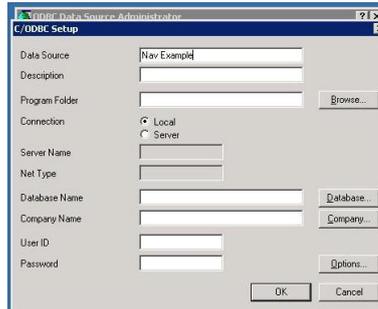
1. Click the Add button



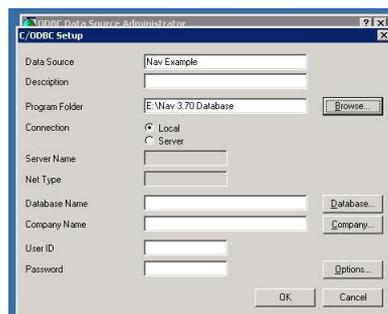
2. Select C/ODBC 32 bit and click Finish button



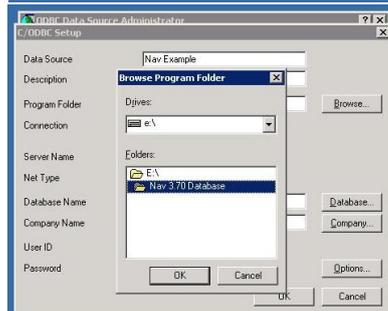
3. Enter Data Source name:



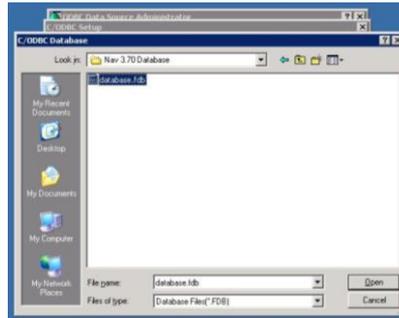
4. Click the Browse button to point to the Navision application folder



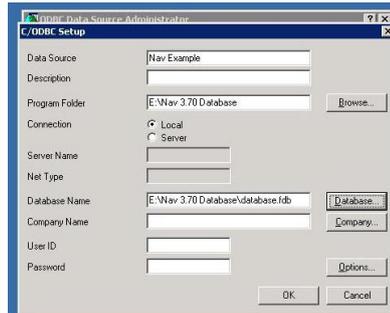
5. Click the Database button to point to the database file



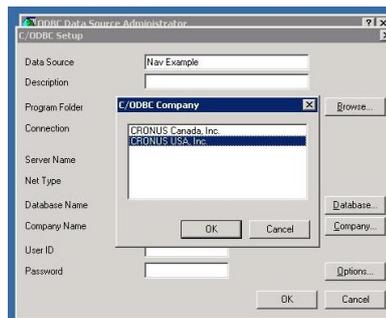
- Navigate to the folder containing the database file.
Select the file and click the Open button



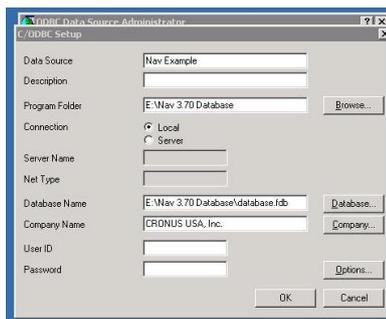
- Click the Company button to select the company to use in timeXtender



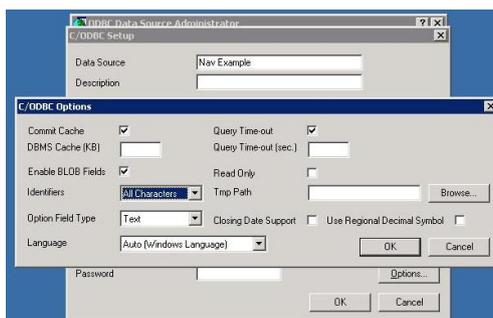
- Select the company and click the OK button



- Click the Option button



- Set the Identifiers to All Characters and click OK button (this dialog looks different from version to version. This screen shot is from Navision 3.70)



- Finally click OK and you are ready to go.

Tips and Tricks working with Navision Native:

If you want to make a selection rule based on a date field use the following statement:

`% CALC%{d 'yyyy-mm-dd'} ex.: %CALC%{d '2007-12-31'}`

For timestamps use

`% CALC%{ts 'yyyy-mm-dd hh:mm:ss'} e x.: %CALC%{ts '2000-01-01 00:00:00'}`

For time use

`% CALC%{t 'hh:mm:ss'} ex.: % CALC%{t '12:15:00'}`
