If you want to make a selection rule based on a date field use the following statement: % CALC%{d 'yyyy-mm-dd'} ex.: %CALC%{d '2007-12-31'}

For timestamps use % CALC%{ts 'yyyy-mm-dd hh:mm:ss'} e x.: %CALC%{ts '2000-01-01 00:00:00'}

For time use % CALC%{t 'hh:mm:ss'} ex.: % CALC%{t '12:15:00'}
